## Dear Deloaks Neighbors,

Just a quick note to update everyone on what's going on in our neighborhood. Firstly, installation of the new signs is complete and the Board has received many compliments on them. This should be a permanent solution and also much more maintainable than our previous wooden signs. Although the Board had not expected or budgeted for this expense in 2016, we were able to split the payments over 2016 and 2017 and come in only \$5,454 over the expense budget for 2016. This expense overrun was more than offset by increased income of \$6,130 above budget due to the aggressive focus of the Board to address delinquent HOA dues. As such, we are starting 2017 in very good financial shape.

Overdue and delinquent HOA dues continues to be a persistent issue and disappointing that most of the Board's time has been focused on addressing this issue. Two liens were placed on Deloaks property owners during 2016 who ignored numerous requests from the Board to address their delinquent status. As a reminder, it is very simple to set up a recurring payment through your bank to pay your quarterly HOA dues or if there are special circumstances, to contact a Board member to discuss payment options.

The Board has contacted the St. Tammany Engineering Department to survey the drainage ditches and clean out those that require it. It may be some weeks until this gets done and we will notify Homeowners before cleanout mucking begins.
